Re: Business Recycling Reporting Ordinance

Dear Mr. Smith:

RethinkWaste, also known as the South Bayside Waste Management Authority (SBWMA), is reaching out to businesses that back haul recyclable materials, and haulers, brokers and other entities that provide recycling collection services to businesses in our service area to inform you of a new reporting requirement. RethinkWaste is a public agency with a Board of Directors of local elected officials and we are tasked with helping our member agencies comply with State laws related to waste reduction and recycling. One of those laws, AB 341, requires commercial recycling be in place for businesses and apartments.

The RethinkWaste Board of Directors recently passed SBWMA Ordinance No. 002 which goes into effect on January 1, 2015 in our service area (on the reverse side of this letter is a map of our service area which includes the communities of: Atherton, Belmont, Burlingame, East Palo Alto, Foster City, Hillsborough, Menlo Park, Redwood City, San Carlos, San Mateo, the County of San Mateo and the West Bay Sanitary District). This Ordinance requires businesses like yours to report recycling data (i.e., weight information on the types of recyclables you collect by city) to us on a quarterly basis starting in 2015. This data will be used to help evaluate whether additional recycling programs are needed for local businesses. For more information on the Ordinance and important dates for the stakeholder engagement meetings, please see the reverse side of this letter.

We are currently constructing a dedicated website to facilitate seamless registration, payment of registration fees and quarterly reporting, and anticipate it to be ready in late February 2015. We will continue to inform you of the website's progress. We appreciate your cooperation with this process and look forward to working with you to obtain the data sought via the Ordinance.

Registration/Administrative Fee

The Ordinance requires each business like yours to register with our agency and pay an annual registration fee to cover administrative expenses. The fee for 2015 is \$150.00 per business and payment is due when registering. The deadline to register is March 15, 2015.

2015 Reporting Deadlines

First Quarter (January, February, March) - Due on May 1, 2015

Second Quarter (April, May, June) – Due August 1, 2015

Third Quarter (July, August, September) – Due on November 1, 2015

Fourth Quarter (October, November, December) – Due on February 1, 2016

Stakeholder Engagement Meetings

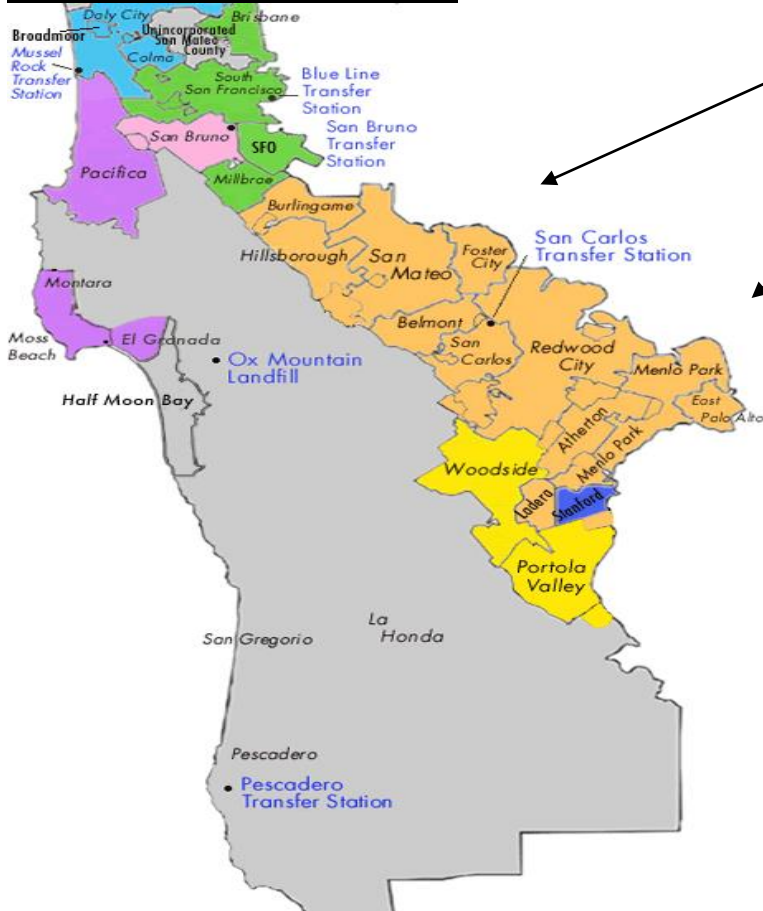
We will be hosting two meetings to answer questions and to demonstrate how to register and submit reports via the website. Our goal is to make your participation as easy and convenient a process as possible.
