RECYCLING MAKES A DIFFERENCE

for recycling.

By recycling one ton of PAPER we save:

- 17 trees
- 6,953 gallons of water
- 463 gallons of oil
- 587 pounds of air pollution
- 3.06 cubic yards of landfill space

For every ton of GLASS recycled,
we save over a ton of resources:

- 1,330 pounds of sand
- 433 pounds of soda ash
- 433 pounds of limestone
- 151 pounds of feldspar
