Non-fiber scrap values were \$224 per ton, a 16% increase from prior month. As predicted, the fiber commodity price correction occurred in April, resulting in a 33% reduction in OCC pricing and 50% reduction in MP pricing.

The SBWMA Clean Wood Recovery Pilot program continues, and we will continue to monitor the recovery efforts and make adjustments as necessary to reduce the amount of clean wood delivered to Zanker Road in San Jose, CA.

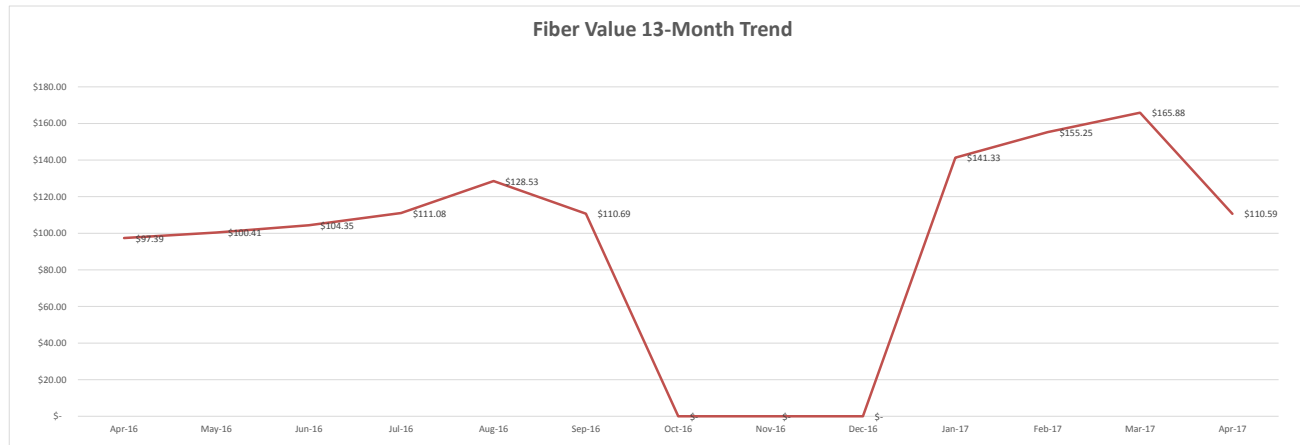
