- 90% of the art piece must be made from recyclable or trash materials collected from everyday life (NO hazardous materials such as batteries or e-waste will be accepted).
- Artwork may be any art medium: sculptures, collages, murals, etc...
- All art pieces should not exceed 3 ft. x 3 ft. in size.
- Artwork must meet one of the following criteria: frame-able, weather resistant, can stand alone, or movable by an individual.
