Commodity Market Update

Scrap values for non-fiber (plastic, glass, aluminum, and metals) remain weak.

Scrap pricing for Mix Paper remains weak, with pricing beginning to stabilize. Cardboard (OCC) pricing ticked up again, but remain below historical levels. However, the fundamentals of supply and demand for OCC indicate that pricing has peaked and will be coming down next month.

Due to the National Sword change in laws, which were implemented throughout 2018 and decimated the recycling industry in 2019, the export market remains weak. Those changes in law continues to impact all MRF's in the US, particularly in CA. As 2020 unfolds SBR's MRF operations continue to suffer devastating economic hardship due to the change in law, which impose higher operating costs and lower revenues

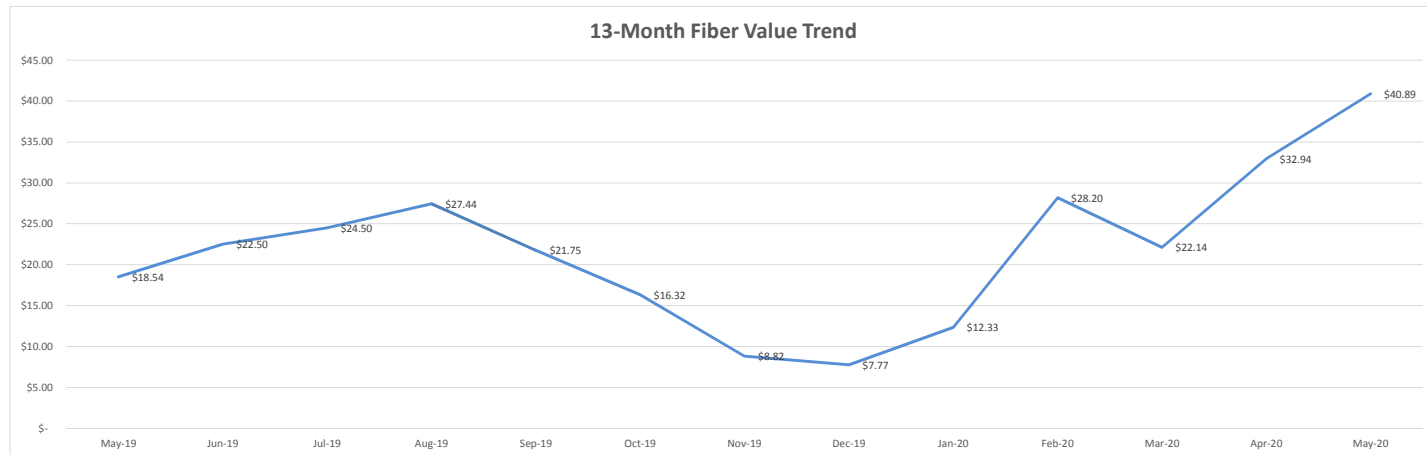
