**Commodity Market Update**

Scrap values for non-fiber (plastic, glass, aluminum, and metals) remain stable, with an increase in the scrap price for #2 HDPE plastic. California Refund Value (CRV) program remains healthy, so there are no meaningful changes anticipated with that revenue.

Scrap pricing for Mix Paper (MP) and Cardboard (OCC) continues to be negatively impacted by severe disruptions to vessel and equipment flows. Goods movement throughout SE Asia have caused transport rates to increase while equipment (export containers and chassis) availability is unpredictable. As a result, all export cargo from the west coast of North America to SE Asia is struggling to find vessels that are capable and willing to move it offshore.

MP and OCC supply far exceeds demand in the western US, and as a result MRFs in CA remain dependent on SE Asian markets. The OCC and MP remains dependent on SE Asia. The good news is those markets want and need the fiber. The bad news is that the lack of export containers and vessel space results in SBR stacking material on site as approved by the local enforcement agency. The on site baled inventory situation remains dynamic and fluid, but at this time there is no need to find alternatives to exporting from the port of Oakland.

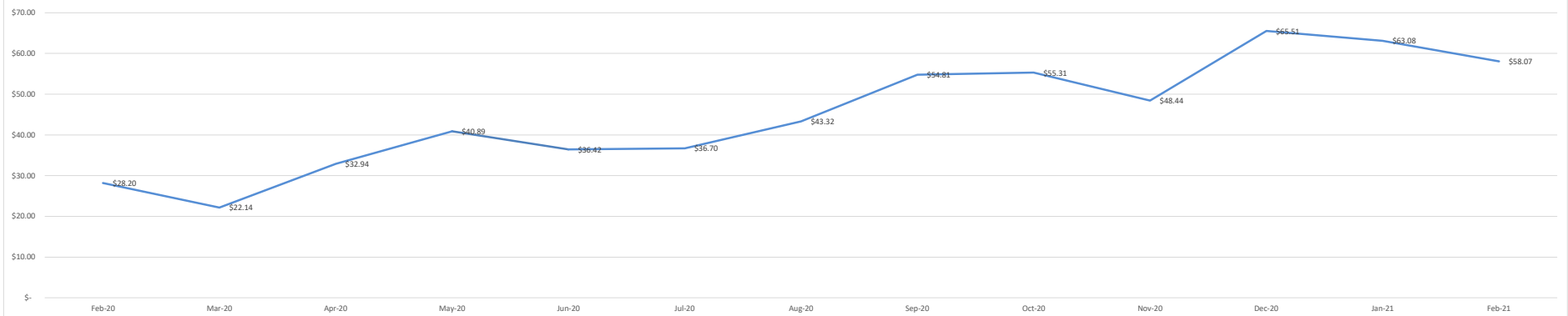
