**Commodity Market Update**

Scrap values for non-fiber (plastic, glass, aluminum, and metals) continue to fluctuate within their normal range. All non-fiber grades are sold to domestic markets.

The Mixed Paper (MP) and OCC produced at SBR continue to move export to Asia directly to end user paper mills. These mills have proper equipment to ensure that the recovered fibers are properly transformed into paper and paperboard in a manner which is socially and environmentally responsible. Although bales of MP and OCC are not currently stacked outside in the permitted area behind the Transfer Station, that area is still being reserved until the port negotiations are concluded.

Negotiations with the International Longshoremen Warehouse Union (ILWU) and the Pacific Maritime Association (PMA) were amicably delayed. There is hope that service disruptions can be avoided.

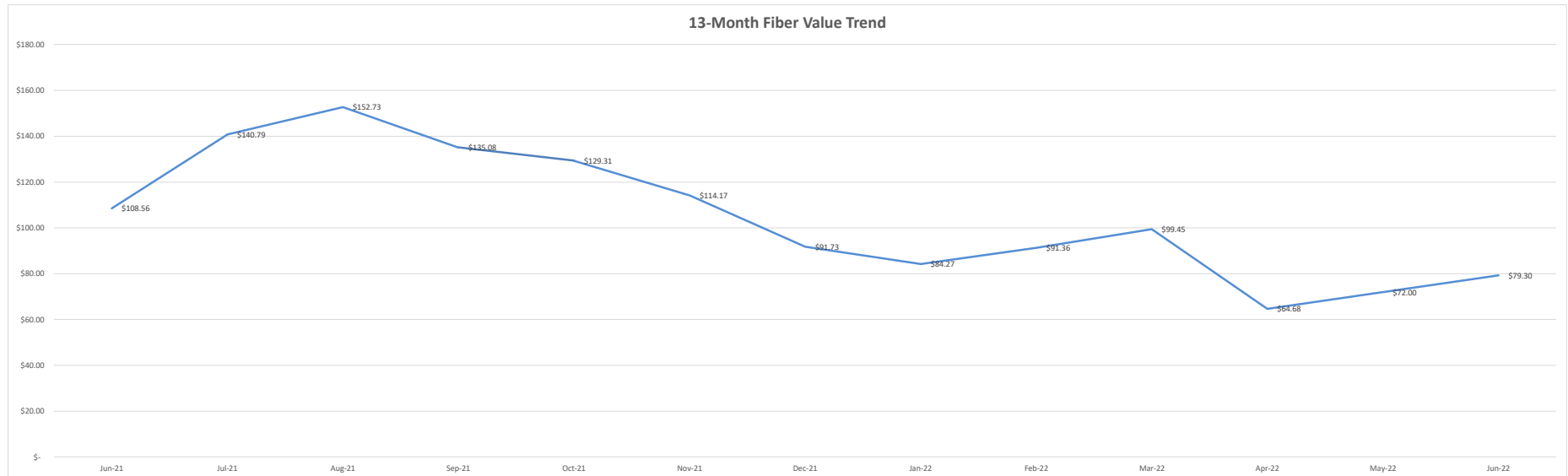
