Commodity Market Update

Scrap values for recovered fiber (OCC cardboard and MP mix paper) remain severely depressed.

Scrap values for plastic, aluminum, and metals remain weak. Glass remains stable.

Complications continue at the port of Oakland, and the ILWU-PMA labor negotiations have still not been resolved. If there is a service disruption then commodity pricing will be even worse.

Over the past several weeks vessel frequency at Oakland has improved, and as a result all bales stored outside have been moved.

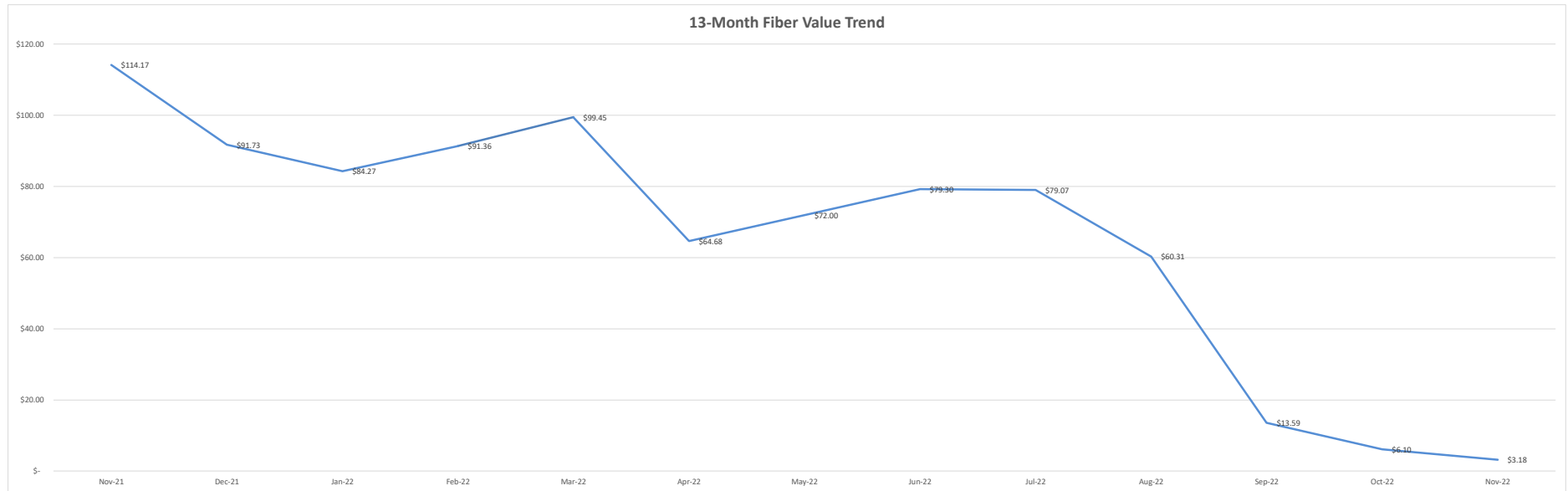
