Since our startup, commodity brokers have consistently provided exceptional transportation of baled commodities, ensuring our bale storage area remains well-managed.

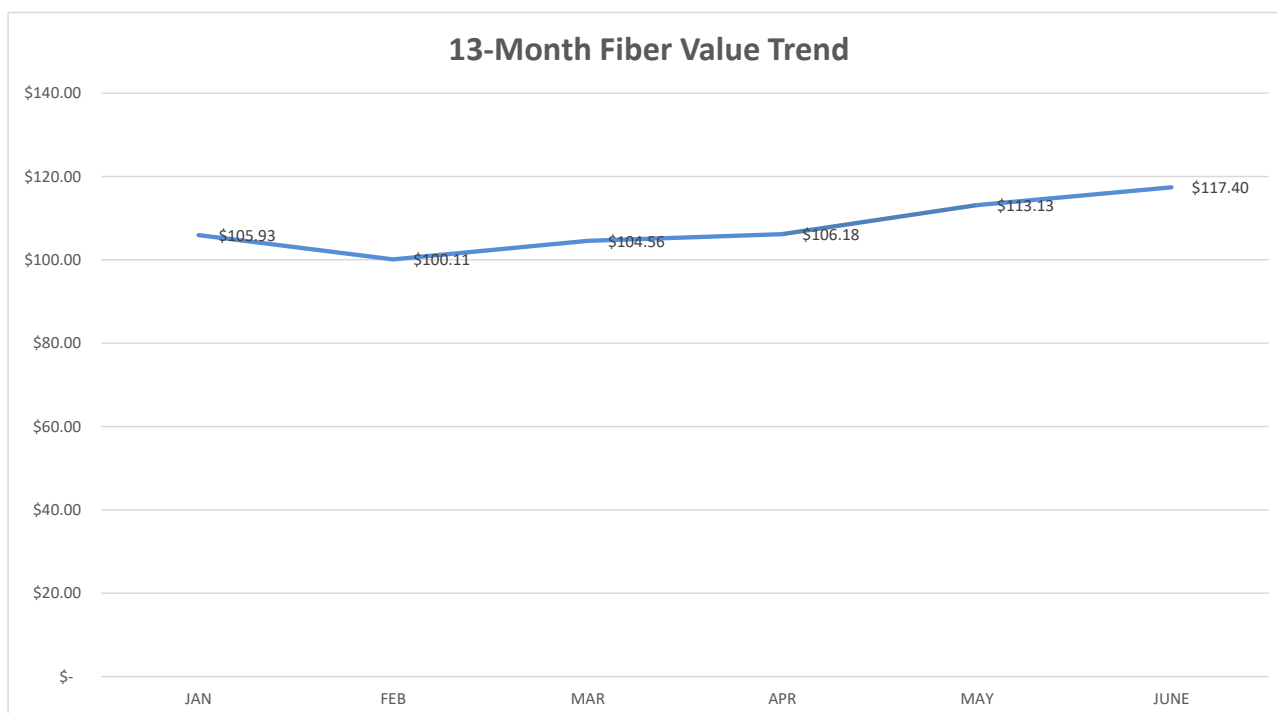
