Residents can bring their paper documents and confidential materials for safe and secure shredding done onsite at the events. Proof of residency is required and there is a maximum limit of three standard size bankers boxes (10"x12"x15") per household.

Accepted items for the events with E-Scrap recycling include TVs, computers, printers, monitors, cables/cords, cell phones, MP3 players, DVD players, laptops, fax machines, keyboards and more, whether they are working or not. Please no household appliances like fans, floor heaters, smoke detectors, vacuum cleaners, cooktops, dishwashers, microwaves, ovens, stoves, refrigerators, freezers, or any household hazardous waste.
