**Commodity Market Update**

Scrap values for non-fiber (plastic, glass, aluminum, and metals) remain weak. Fortunately, the California CRV program is financially solvent, and payments from the State for Refund, Processing, and Administration will continue to be made by CalRecycle. Non-fiber pricing (scrap + CRV) improved slightly. Scrap pricing for fiber (cardboard and paper) remains very weak and unstable. Cardboard (OCC) dropped slightly and Mixed Paper was unchanged.

End users consuming recovered fiber continue to demand higher quality dry material. The global market for Mixed Paper is in oversupply, and that pricing remains very weak. It is likely that next month FOB origin pricing for Mixed Paper will be negative, which happens when the trucking cost to move bales from Shoreway to the Port of Oakland exceeds the market value loaded into containers and delivered FAS (Free Alongside Ship) to the Port of Oakland. Q1 2019 had lots of rain, and this excess moisture (common in the industry, even though carts have lids) negatively impacts MRF throughput, increases contamination levels in sorted products, and reduces the market value for paper and cardboard. When moisture levels of sorted products exceed 20% then the risks of moisture claims, including shipment rejections, and the severity of them increases.

China continues their ban on Mixed Paper, and this poses a serious threat to both pricing and movement. There are no viable domestic markets for Mixed Paper in California, and as a result the entire MRF industry in California is dependent on export markets in SE Asia. Those markets do not have the capacity to absorb all of the Mixed Paper coming from CA MRFs, and as a result pricing remains very weak. As a result, some municipal programs have stopped collecting paper at curbside and others are composting it. Fortunately, we are close to the port of Oakland, so our transportation cost for moving baled fiber to the port is much less than it would be if we were hundreds of miles away from the port.

China continues to reduce their imports of Cardboard (OCC), and most of what they do purchase is from post-industrial or pre-consumer sources. China controls the import using quotas and permits, and they are being reduced in 2019. There are very limited domestic markets for Cardboard in California, and as a result most MRF cardboard is exported to SE Asia. This has created an oversupply of material, which has caused prices to decline and remain depressed. Fortunately mills in SE Asia prefer USA origin cardboard versus that originating from Japan or Europe. However, cardboard pricing is well below historical averages and is unlikely to rebound in Q2 2019.

There remains a tremendous uncertainty regarding whether or not China will ban the import of all recyclables in 2020. If that were to happen then the impact on the recycling industry in North America would be catastrophic.

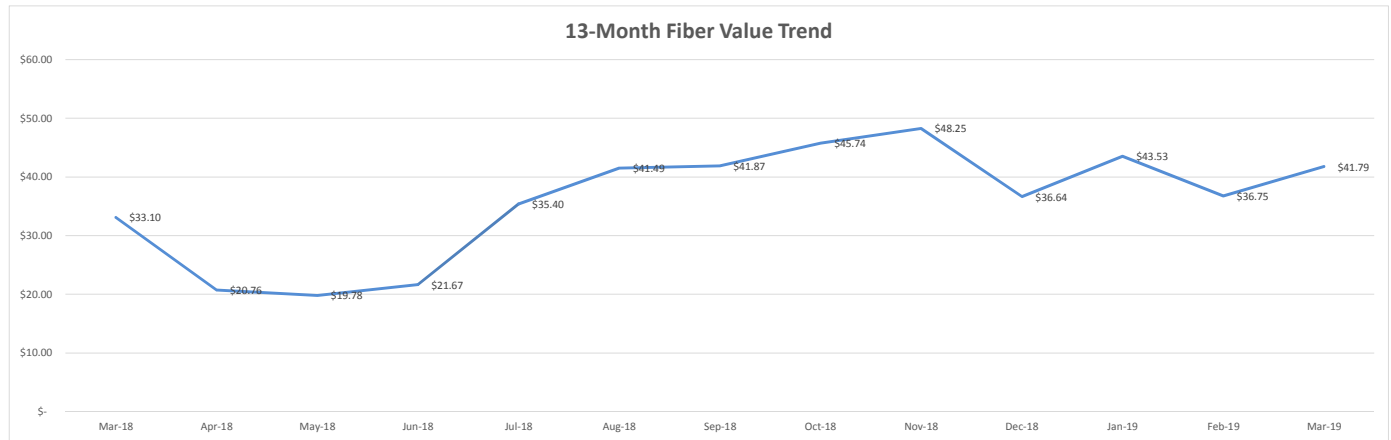
